Introduction

The importance of studying Hadith

The Sunnah (the actions, sayings and approvals of Prophet Muhammad, salallaahu alayhi wa sallam, is the second source of Islamic legislation and must be in complete agreement with the first source (i.e. the Quran).



First Hadith

Abu Hurairah (May Allah be pleased with him) reported: The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "It is also charity to utter a good word." [Al- Bukhari and Muslim].

والكلمة الطيبة صدقة

Second Hadith

'Uthman bin 'Affan (May Allah be pleased with him) reported: The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "The best amongst you is the one who learns the Qur'an and teaches it." [Al-Bukhari].

Third Hadith

Abu Hurairah (May Allah be pleased with him) reported: The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "Whoever believes in Allah and the Last Day, let him show hospitality to his guest"

Your Task

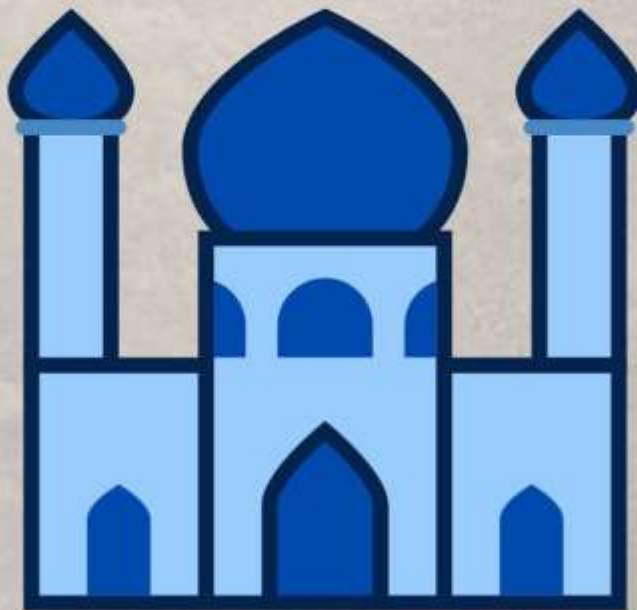
- Greet the guests warmly, welcome them to your home and show them into a comfortable and appropriate room.

Fourth Hadith

It was narrated that Abu Sa'eed Al-Khudri said: "The Messenger of Allah said: 'When you hear the call (to prayer), say what the Mu'adh-dhin says.'"

Fifth Hadith

Anas (May Allah be pleased with him) reported: The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "No one of you becomes a true believer until he likes for his brother what he likes for himself". [Al-Bukhari and Muslim].

Your Task

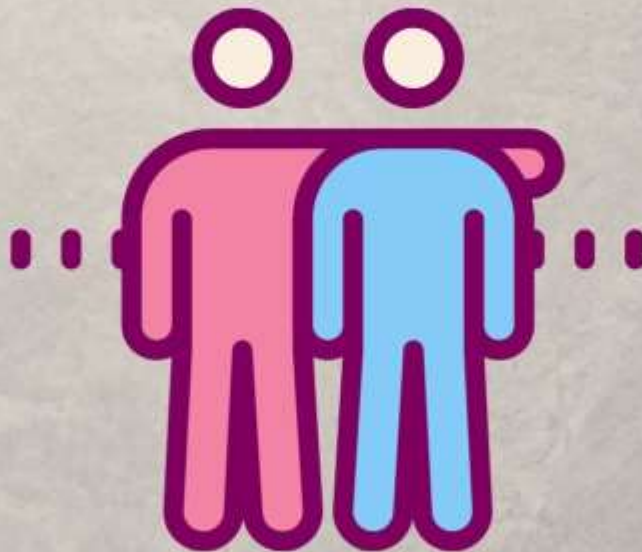
- Treat people as you would like them to treat you.

Abu Musa Al-Ash'ari (May Allah be pleased with him) reported: The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "A person will be summoned with the one whom he loves". [Al-Bukhari and Muslim].

Seventh Hadith

Abu Sa'id Al-Khudri (May Allah be pleased with him) reported about Surat Al-Ikhlās (Chapter 112): **The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "By Him in Whose Hand my soul is, it is equivalent to one-third of the Qur'an."**

Eighth Hadith

'Abdullah ibn 'Amr ibn al-'As reported that it reached him that the Prophet, may Allah bless him and grant him peace, said,
"Anyone who does not show mercy to our children nor acknowledge the right of our old people is not one of us."

كَبِيرَنَا، فَلَيْسَ مِنَّا
